Referral process for Inpatient Admission

- 1** Phone Intake on **03 5240 0741**
- 2** **Intake Clinician will require:**
Patient's name | Address | Contact numbers | Health Insurance details | Date of Birth
Outline current issues | Current regime | Previous treatments | Any risk history or potential risk factors
Fax referral letter to: **03 5240 0799**
- 3** **Referrals for Admission**
Intake clinician will contact duty Psychiatrist, Registrar, or Manager of specialist program to discuss referral
- 4** **Intake clinician will contact patient**
Any additional information will be obtained (including current risk assessment) and the patient will be informed of the outcome of their health fund check)
- 5** **Intake clinician will discuss with referrer**
Suitability of referral according to entry criteria of program Patient's health insurance status
- 6** **If admission criteria is met and Psychiatrist is willing to admit:**
Patient will be contacted to arrange admission time. Referring doctor will be notified of patient's admission date and their treating psychiatrist.
Following patient discharge, a nursing discharge and medical discharge summary will be sent to the referrer.
